

CODE OF CONDUCT - PLAYERS

- > I will never argue with an official.
- ➤ I will control my temper.
- > I will work equally hard for my team and myself.
- > I will be a good sport.
- ➤ I will treat people with respect just as I would like to be treated.
- > I will cooperate with my Coach, Captain, Team mates and Club Officials.
- ➤ I will respect the rights and dignity of others regardless of their gender, ability, cultural background or religion.
- ➤ If my wrongful behavior, including swearing, is brought to the attention of the coach, repeatedly, then I understand my parents/guardians will be notified and a suitable action (consequence) will occur.



CODE OF CONDUCT FOR PARENTS/GUARDIANS

- ➤ I/We will never ridicule or yell at a child for making a mistake or losing a competition.
- > I/We will support all efforts to remove verbal and physical abuse.
- > I/We will show respect for any officials or volunteer coach's decisions and to teach children to do likewise.
- > I/We will remember that my child is participating for their enjoyment not mine/ours.
- ➤ It is my/our responsibility to look after my/our child at training and on game day due to safety and behavior reasons. If I/We cannot be in attendance then I/We will make arrangements for someone over 18yrs of age to be there to look after my/our child. The coach/committee reserve the right to remove your child if a situation arises and there is no adult present.
- > I/We will respect the rights, dignity and worth of **every** player and official regardless of their gender, ability, cultural background or religion.
- ➤ If I/We have an issue with **any** aspect of the Montrose Cricket Club we will follow the correct procedure of contacting a Committee Member or President.
